




### **Fruit Full JECRC Inauguration**





Beings since time immemorial. India had immense forest wealth years ago but the condition has severely deteriorated over the years. Due to industrialization, urbanization and man's never-ending greed, these very source of life are being harvested indiscriminately.

Trees are the very essence of life on this planet. They provide us grains, herbs, flowers and fuel. In our culture tree plantation has been encouraged and mother nature has been revered since ancient times.

Trees improve the air quality and even help in conserving water. They also prevent soil erosion during heavy rains or floods as the roots have a firm grip on the soil. They give asylum to the wildlife. The earth has even observed extinction of many species of birds and animals due to this removal of their natural habitat. A large forest cover is also responsible for a healthy ecosystem. Fruit bearing trees not only give us the fresh and nutritious fruits but also reduce unnecessary external shipping of locally grown produce. Thus decreasing the use of fossil fuels and packing material. So our forest wealth must be protected at all costs or our world will cease to be the beauty it is.

# Benefits of Tree

Trees give us oxygen, store carbon, stabilise the soil and give life to the world's wildlife. They also provide us with the materials for tools and shelter.

Not only are trees essential for life, but as the longest living species on earth, they give us a link between the past, present and future.

One tree produces 100kg (Approx) of oxygen per year. A human breathes about 740kg of oxygen per year. Which is roughly 7.4 trees in a year.



### Trees benefit health

The canopies of trees act as a physical filter, trapping dust and absorbing pollutants from the air. They also provide shade from solar radiation and reduce noise.

Trees and shrubs are known to have medicinal properties.

Research shows that within minutes of being surrounded by trees and green space, reduces blood pressure, heart rate slows and stress levels comes down.



### Trees benefit the environment

Trees absorb carbon dioxide as they grow and the carbon that they store in their wood helps slow the rate of global warming.

They reduce wind speeds and cool the air as they lose moisture and reflect heat upwards from their leaves. It's estimated that trees can reduce the temperature in a city by up to 7°C.

Trees also help prevent flooding and soil erosion, absorbing thousands of litres of storm principal College 5.

Urban woodland can be used as an educational resource and to bring groups together for activities like walking and bird-watching. Trees are also invaluable for children to play in and discover their sense of adventure.

People are attracted to live, work and invest in green surroundings. Research shows that average house prices are 5-18% higher when properties are close to mature trees. Companies benefit from a healthier, happier workforce if there are parks and trees nearby.



# Trees boost wildlife

Trees host complex microhabitats.

They offer habitation and food to amazing communities of birds and insects.

\*\*Trees are the lungs of earth, saving them is definitely worth





The first stage in the life cycle of a tree is a seed. A seed begins to grow when warmth and moisture swell the seed causing its skin to split. A tiny root grows downward, collecting water and minerals from the soil and anchoring the seed. At the same time a shoot pushes up towards the light. Both the root and the shoot grow from the embryo, the smallest part of the seed.



The next phase is the sapling stage, this is when the sprout continues to grow and has not yet reached the stage of complete maturity. During this stage, the sapling is not big enough to be considered a full grown mature tree. The sapling stage can be compared to when a child grows into a teenager. Saplings grow quickly but they are unable to reproduce (grow seeds) at this point.



This is the first occasion you will see a stem and perhaps a couple of leaves. There are numerous things that could harm the sprout from developing; these include too much or too little water, too much sun, fire or being eaten by insects or animals.



The final stage of the life cycle of a tree is when it has fully grown and reached the last stage of maturity. This is the adult stage of its life and since the tree is fully grown it can now grow seeds, fruit and/or nuts. The mature tree has many branches, the growh is wide and the leaves are fully grown and bright in callour.
