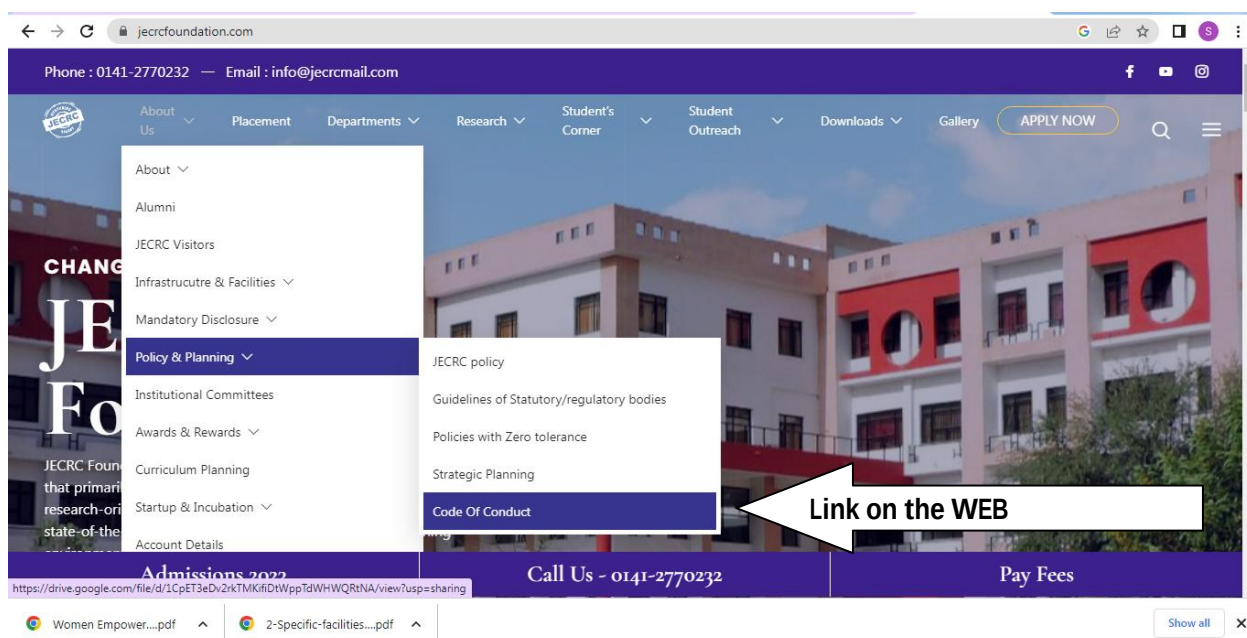


7.1.10 - Relevant Information
