
Verbal Communication

Types of Verbal Communication

- Oral Communication: In oral communication spoken words are used which includes face-to-face conversation, speeches, telephonic conversation, radio television etc.
- Advantage: This communication is speedy, in face-to-face conversation we can read the facial expressions.
- Disadvantage: In Face-to-face conversation you are unable to think deeply.



Written Communication

- This communications includes written words, memos, letters, charts etc.
- This communication is most common form of business communication.
- This communication is less speedy as compared to oral.



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Characteristics of effective verbal communication

- Consider the object
- Be sincere and simple use language
- Be brief and concise
- Use polite words and soft tone.

Nonverbal communication includes all unwritten and unspoken messages, both intentional and unintentional.





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


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






A person to have quality communication skills must possess the knowledge of non-verbal communication. As compared to words and vocal variety non-verbal communication matters a
